Pastels

Bring a **reasonable** set of pastels that you can manage. Color range is more important than quantity. Do not bring everything you have! I travel with the double-sketch size Heilman box (very small!) I use a wide variety of brands including Terry Ludwig, Nu-Pastels, Mount Vision, Unison, Blue Earth.

The most important thing is that you are comfortable and can carry **ALL** of your materials + equipment. If you can't, you will be sorry!

Plein Air Set Up

Bring a lightweight plein air easel. I use a tripod and a Heilman box with an easel attachment.

There are many good options available. Whatever you choose, please get familiar with it prior to the workshop as you will be responsible for setting up taking down and carrying your own gear! Be sure to bring a backpack or carrying case to tote paper, water, and other essentials.
